

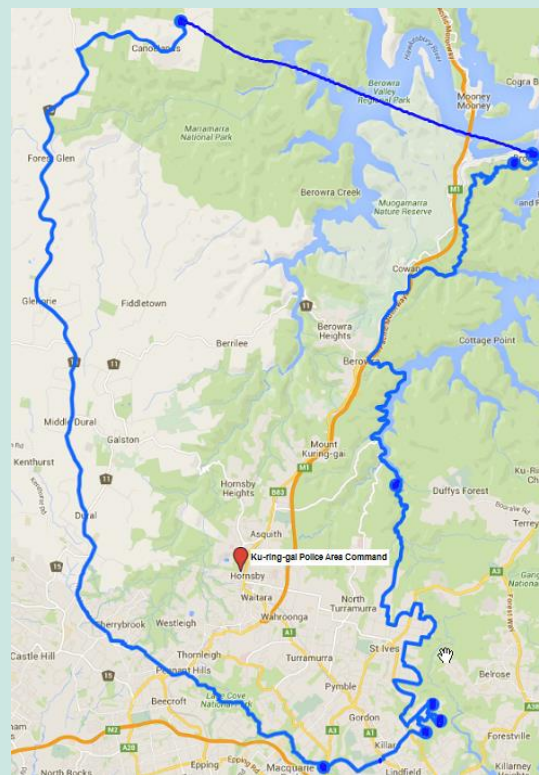
Helpful Tips:

- Download the Police **Emergency Plus** App. It gives your exact GPS coordinates.
- Always report any suspicious behaviour you see to police. It may be part of a bigger picture and help to solve a crime.
- Don't let your neighbourhood be trashed - report all graffiti & vandalism ASAP.
- Please take a look at the **Our 20 Favourite Crime Prevention Tips** series for advice on various subjects, including: Apartments, the Festive Season, New Neighbours, Protect Your Identity, etc. Other languages are available.
- Please take a look at our **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)** for answers to many common questions, including: Intruders, Moving House, First Dates, etc.
- Scan/copy both sides of the cards in your wallet, giving you contact info, if stolen.
- If a neighbour is on holiday, offer to:
 - clear their mailbox
 - take out/pull in their garbage bins
 - move any newspapers
 - park in their driveway
 - keep an eye on their home
 - water pot plants or
 - mow their council strip.

What can we do for you?

We have various items below that we can give you, or you can borrow, or which you can print. Please take a look at our au-NHWKuringgaiHornsby.org website.

- Are you displaying a house number on your kerb? This is essential for emergency services to identify an address. Borrow a **KerbWatch kit**, including stencils, cone, paint, regulations & everything you need.
- Are you displaying Neighbourhood Watch (NHW) **stickers** on your front and back windows? These can act as a deterrent.
- Have you secured your vehicle rego plates with **one-way locking screws**? Your plates don't have to be special to be stolen. They are simply used on another vehicle to avoid easy recognition, eg criminals fill their car with fuel and fail to pay.
- Are you impacted by drivers blocking your driveway? Paint white lines at each side for a psychological deterrent. Borrow a **stencil kit**, including wooden stencil, cones, regulations & all the info you need.
- Have you marked your valuable items? Marking your items can help return your property to you. It can also tie a criminal to a crime scene, allowing for a better chance of conviction. Borrow an **engraver & ultra-violet pen**, along with advice on the best way to mark your property.
- We also offer **shredders, garbage bin warning stickers, Little Black Book of Scams**, etc., as well as help and advice.
